## **Program Description:**

CWC is a rehabilitation facility that cares for approximately 4,000 ill and injured native California wildlife each year, including avian, terrestrial, and marine species. We offer a hands-on wildlife medicine externship with experience in handling/restraint, physical examination, anesthesia, diagnostics, treatments, and animal care/husbandry techniques. Students participate daily in clinical case discussions, and time permitting, additional discussions covering various wildlife medicine topics such as physical examination, anatomy, anesthesia, emergency/critical care, wound and fracture management, and preventive medicine will be covered. Additional experience may include soft tissue and orthopedic surgery, necropsy, supplemental lectures, wetlabs and journal discussions.

## **Housing/Transportation:**

Housing and transportation are the responsibility of the extern.

## **Requirements:**

Experience in wildlife rehabilitation and/or veterinary medicine is highly recommended. Veterinary students, pre-veterinary applicants, as well as those applicants that demonstrate a career or prolonged interest in wildlife medicine will be given priority, usually in that order. The applicant must have had a tetanus shot/booster within the past 10 years. Rabies vaccination is not required, but is highly recommended in order to work with rabies vector species.

Please submit a letter of intent, resume, and (2) professional letters of recommendation. The letter of intent and resume should be in PDF format and may be submitted via email. Letters of recommendation may be submitted via email as well. Applications are accepted and positions are filled on a rolling basis. When applying, please include your available dates for the externship (a few or more options is best).
